
#### We are under the Petaluma Youth Soccer League ("PYSL")








### Veo Game Cameras


NCFC has two (2) Veo game cameras.

- Video is available online and can be shared with players and parents.
- Clips can be created for coaching, education and for older players college recruiting.

#### When?


- Once players master


