



## NCFC Volunteer hour rules (Updated 3/31/2022)

Players receiving player assistance hours are as follows:

- 2 Parent Families: 5 hours total by September PA deposit, 10 hours total by December PA deposit, and 15 hours total by May PA deposit.
- 1 Parent Families: 4 hours total by September PA deposit, 7 hours total by December PA deposit, and 10 hours total by May PA deposit.

Board members receive a \$440 registration credit and will not be allowed further credit for additional volunteering.

Managers and treasurers already receive \$300 credit for volunteering.

(This will be refunded to you via got sport or via check \* Limit one credit per person) However, we allow a max of 5 hours (\$20 per hour) = to \$100 for other volunteering to be paid by the club directly to the volunteer. (Not to be deducted for dues) \*If your team decides to have a scheduler, the manager will split the \$300 refund with the scheduler.

Equipment volunteer gets \$100 credit and will be allowed an additional 15 hours = \$300 for other volunteering opportunities.

Team Travel Coordinator gets \$50 credit and will be allowed an additional 10 Hours = \$300 for other volunteering opportunities.

All other volunteers will be paid \$20 per hour with a max of 15 hours = to \$300 (If we do not receive enough volunteers, we will make an exception to those who help with field lining, tryouts, and Sol games only)
